- If shipped by U.P.S., trees are topped at 42".
- Trees are shipped to arrive at retail nurseries between mid-January and mid-February, 2011. Later dates in colder climates. Actual ship dates depend on weather.

What Is Backyard Orchard Culture?

Since the goals are different, it is not commercial orchard culture. It is **high density planting**. Lots of trees in a small area; hedgerows, espaliers, four trees in one whole, multiple-budded trees. It is **successive ripening**. One variety after another—fruit all season long. It is **summer pruning** for tree size control. It is a take-charge, can-do attitude with respect to pruning, thinning and spraying.
